Skills/Requirements:

- Must provide your own filming/camera/film editing equipment and have the ability to upload work to a shared space (e.g. Google Drive)
- Desire to work with all types of people with an ability to be sensitive and compassionate; reliability and good time management; ability to show good judgement and be a self-starter; positive attitude; good sense of humour; conflict management skills or experience in non-violent de-escalation an asset.
- Must feel comfortable working around bees, beekeeping (we will provide suit/veil/gloves if requested)
- Ability to travel/transit to locations within Metro Vancouver
